

Brass Monkey Camp 2012

Camp leaders (Dennis Sweeting's) Rules

- No mobile phones or electrical equipment.
- No growing plants or standing timber will be damaged
- All competitors are responsible for their site; any site left in a mess after the event will result in that team's scout leader having to arrange for them to return and tidy the site.
- No competitors will begin construction of their bivouac until after they have signed in, this will not be before 10am on the Saturday.
- All competitors will bring a ground sheet.
- All spare clothing to be kept in a labelled waterproof bag.
- Help from leaders or parents on site will result in points being deducted.
- Gadgets and cooking implements may be made prior to camp.
- You may bring materials for bivouac building with you but it must be removed from site at the end of camp.
- All sites will be allotted on arrival by drawing numbers.
- Waterproof clothing plus a warm hat are to be shown on arrival. If you have none then you will be sent home.
- Bivouacs must be completed by 13.00 on the Saturday.
- Dinner will be marked between 17.00 and 18.30.
- NO axes allowed.
- Any competitor found with alcohol or cigarettes on site will be sent home and suspended.
- No Scout will be allowed off the campsite without the consent of Dennis Sweeting (camp leader)
- Each team must have a first aid kit
- **Parents** - if a problem arises with a boy/girl, they will be sent home.
- Each team must have a bucket

All Sites will be patrolled at all times.

AT REGISTRATION

Please arrive at Thriftwood by 10am. You will not be registered until **ALL** your team is together.

You must have with you:

- Copy of menu
- Your programme for the camp
- Name of your team leader
- Health form for each Scout
- Evidence of waterproofs, warm clothing & a hat. **No Waterproof / Hat / Warm Clothing = No Registration**

Scout Leaders (Nick's) Rules

- All equipment borrowed from Elphwood to be used at Brass Monkey must be transported by parents/guardians.
- Camp finishes after the award ceremony (usually at 10:30am) on the Sunday. No-one leaves before 10:30.
- Anything taken from home to be used at camp must be removed from Thriftwood once the camp ends.
- Each Scout must bring their uniform shirt and scarf - scarves must be worn during registration - to camp. Wear warm clothes to camp and I advise that you wear wellington boots (or similar). Place your uniform in a carrier bag and make sure that it is easily accessible at the top of your main bag. If the weather permits on the Sunday morning, you will be asked to put your uniform on for the award ceremony.
- Please ensure all your personal property is clearly marked with your name.
- Parents / Guardians - please avoid being late to collect scouts on the Sunday.
